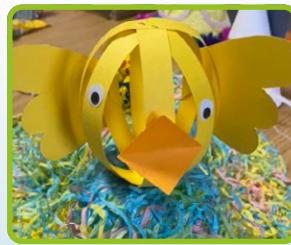

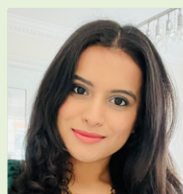

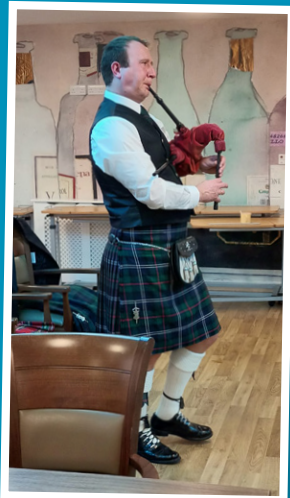


Celebrations at Amicura Homes

EASTER CELEBRATIONS

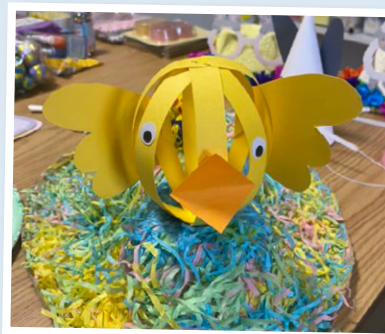
The residents of **The Rivers** made beautiful easter bonnets and decorated an easter tree.

At **Harmony House**, all the beautiful mothers received a lovely gift from Lisa, the activities coordinator followed by a pamper session. The day was very special.

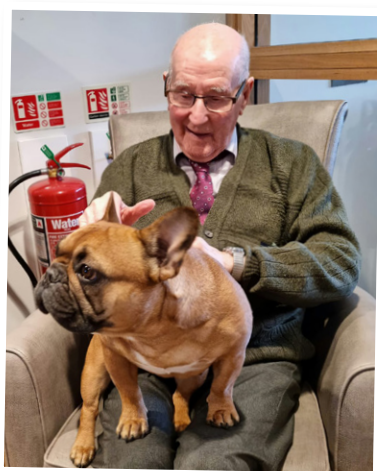
The ladies of **Haslingden Hall** had big smiles as they receive flowers and cards on Mother's Day

At **The Glen**, residents made beautiful table ornaments, it was extra special for all the mothers to spend the day with their families over a delicious meal.



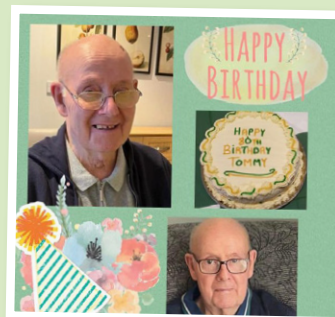
NATIONAL PUPPY DAY

Harmony House had an Ink and Drink event; the residents had a fun time getting temporary tattoos and enjoying refreshments.



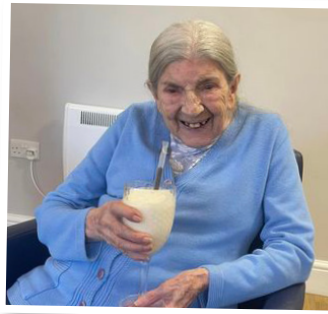
ONE-TO-ONE ACTIVITIES AT KINGSLEY

GENTS CLUB OF ROSEWAY HOUSE

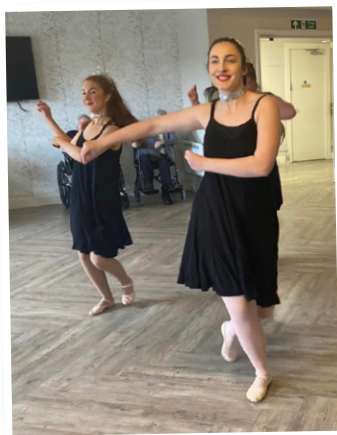
The gentlemen of **Roseway House** had their regular domino sessions over a cup of coffee in the home café, it is one of their favourite activities to do.

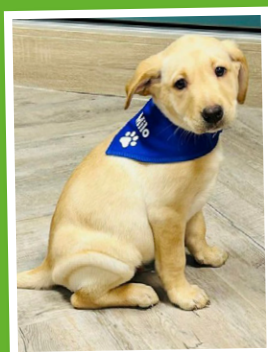
INTERGENERATIONAL THERAPY

The weather doesn't stop the horticulturists of **Haslingden Hall** as they made hanging baskets to hang in the front of the home.

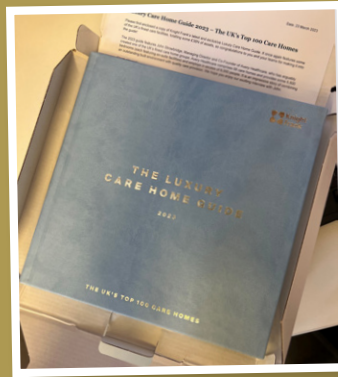

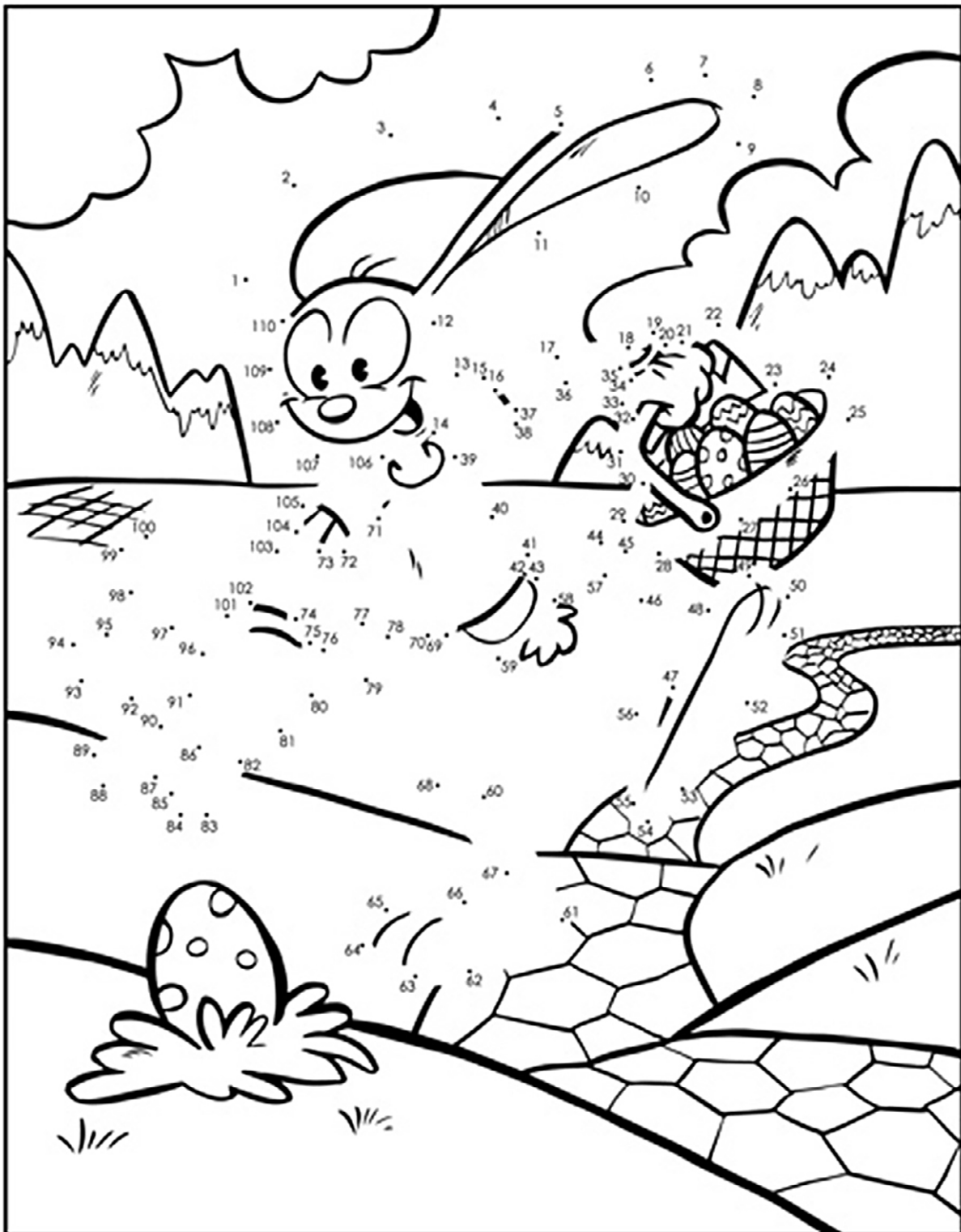
